Attention State Health Plan Members: An Important Message from the State Treasurer

Clear Pricing Project Update: How YOU Can Help

Providers have less than 30 days to sign a contract and become partners with the State Health Plan on the Clear Pricing Project!

If providers do not sign a contract by July 1, 2019, they will be considered **out-of-network** for State Health Plan members beginning January 1, 2020.

As a reminder, this only affects members on the 80/20 Plan, the 70/30 Plan and the High Deductible Health Plan and only includes medical providers in North Carolina.

How you can help!

- 1. Ask your provider if they plan on signing a contract by July 1, 2019, to keep them in-network by joining the new North Carolina State Health Plan Network.
- 2. If they say no, ask them why they are against transparency and lowering the cost of health care.
- 3. Encourage co-workers or friends who are Plan members to join in the effort!
