

North Carolina State Health Plan Network Update

NC State Health Plan Network Opens To New Providers!

The State Health Plan (Plan) will be reopening the NC State Health Plan Network for new medical providers to join. Medical providers will have from June 1 to June 30, 2022, to sign up. Providers who join will be included in the network effective January 1, 2023.

Current CPP providers do not need to take any action during this time.

Starting June 1, 2022, providers interested in joining the network can find additional information and required documents on the NC State Health Plan Network page of the Plan's website.

Below is a plan comparison chart for the 2022 benefit year. At this time, there will be no changes in copays for the 2023 benefit year.
